Health and safety policy

As a minimum requirement, Mana Cruising Club will ensure ongoing compliance with legislation and accepted standards, so that safe and healthy facilities and practices are maintained for our members, employees, contractors and visitors. This will be achieved by:

- Aiming for best practice in safety in all Club activities.

As required by legislation, and by our Club rules, members, contractors and employees are required to play their part in ensuring the safety and well-being of themselves and others and are required to:

- Perform all tasks in a safe manner in compliance with safe work practices, statutory regulations and safety management system requirements.
- Isolate all dangerous situations and promptly report all incidents and unsafe practices to Club personnel.
- Co-operate and consult with each other to ensure that everyone's safety responsibilities are fulfilled.
